

Trego Lake District Meeting – Minutes/Notes

Quarterly Meeting – Spring 2018
Saturday, April 14, 2018, 9:00 a.m.
Trego Town Hall, Trego, Wisconsin

The meeting was called to order at 9:03 a.m. by Chair Tim Reedy. Present were Tim Reedy, Gary Kaiser and Tom Frost. A quorum of the Board of Commissioners was not present. The meeting was cancelled. Official business of the Board will take place at the summer Quarterly meeting.

An informal discussion of the following items took place:

- Board elections at Annual Meeting: There will be three Board positions to be filled at the Annual Meeting: Dan DuRose's (3 year), Gary Kaiser's (3 year), Dick Okerlund's (Dick resigned with one year remaining on his term).
- Aquatic Invasive Species: Tim discussed DNR grant for Aquatic Invasive Species inspections at the TLD landing this summer. The 4-H club is interested in the project. Tim is in contact with them. Training is needed and available for both the 4-H leadership and Lake District members. Training is scheduled for April 30 - 3:30 to 4:30, Spooner Ag Station.
- Audit Committee Report
- Proposed Budget 2018-19 was reviewed and discussed. All three present Board members support it. John Geiger has also indicated support. The Board will recommend adoption of the Budget as proposed at the Annual Meeting.
- Buoys - Tim Reedy is coordinating and leading
- Public Landing – Terry Tonnar is coordinating and leading.
- National Park Service/Charlie Lundin reported on NPS website and desire to link it to TLD's new website. Website contact is Jean Van Thoven. TLD's request for "No Wake" signs under consideration. NPS may be requesting new signage at the landing this summer. Jean is contact for that issue as well. Volunteer caretakers have been found for Earl campground for 2018 summer. Ban on having glass on boats or anywhere on water is in effect -- \$130 fine for violation.
- Discussion of effect of dredging. River continues to change, some spots filled in last summer and fall.
