

Trego Lake District Meeting Minutes

Quarterly Meeting – Summer 2018
Saturday, August 4, 2018
Trego Town Hall, Trego, Wisconsin

Board members present: Tim Reedy, John Geiger, Dan Frase, Gary Kaiser, Charlie Petersen, Tom Frost

The meeting was called to order at 9:01 a.m. by Board Chair Tim Reedy. Lake District members introduced themselves.

There was a motion, second and vote approving the minutes of the January 7, 2018, Board Meeting and the June 9, 2018, Annual Meeting.

Board chair's Report

- Chair Tim Reedy provided an update on the Clean Boat/Clean Water initiative by Trego Lake District. We have been unable to secure volunteers to provide coverage at the landing during scheduled hours. Lake District will accept volunteers or will pay (\$12/hr) for this service. Anyone is eligible to do this. Contact is Tim Reedy.
- Charlie Petersen led discussion about issues relating to sedimentation and channel maintenance. At end of discussion Chair Reedy appointed Charlie to be the chair of the new sedimentation committee. Charlie will report to the Board by the April 2019 meeting and will report and request action at the 2019 Annual Meeting.

Treasurer Tom Frost reported on expenses and income since the January meeting. Account balances with bank statement. Motion, second and vote approving report,

Committee Reports

- Weed Harvesting: Tom Frost reported that weed harvest was cancelled this year due to fewer weeds in channels. Deposit with harvester was forfeited. After discussion Xcel Energy agreed to reimburse Trego Lake District for forfeited deposit. Trego Lake District representatives will meet with Xcel Energy representatives this fall to discuss future weed harvesting issues.
- Water Quality: No report.
- Buoys, Public Landing Pier – Tim Reedy reported two buoys came loose. One was re-placed, the other will be after welding. Issues relating to placement of buoys were discussed. Because of change in sedimentation deposits, buoys no longer reliably marked channels. Discussion on how to mark channels and locate “No Wake” buoys.
- Fish Stocking / Management: Tim Reedy reported on discussions with the DNR on stocking walleye. He reconfirmed that the lake will be “shocked” in 2019 in order to establish fish populations.

- Website: Barb Emerson reported that committee has been meeting by email. She asked several questions from the committee. The goal of the committee is to launch the website by September 1.
