These are the two domain names owned by TLD. As of this date, Google has indexed the site, so it is now available by searching on Google. (This usually takes a couple of months.)

Making comments on the website is restricted to members only. So far, 26 members have requested and received logins. The procedure for requesting your own login is to fill out the User Registration form located on this page of the site:

A link to this form is provided at the bottom of all pages on the website. When you submit the form, I receive the request, check your name/email against the master list of members and email your username. Members set their own passwords.

During the past month, we have had roughly 127 visitors to the site.
